S-Lists versus Arrays

- * Which is better for storing:
- * A data base of users, initially one that is very small. SList! It can actually change its size (unlike and array), although it will quite slow.
- * The names of the 50 state governors? Array! This is the fasters option, and the number of items never changes so we don't worry about resizing.
